



The polls shows 57% of respondents in Gaza and 82% in the West Bank believe Hamas was correct in launching its October 7 onslaught, in which some 1,200 people in Israel, mostly civilians, were murdered and over 240 were taken hostage. A large majority believes Hamas's claims that it acted to "defend" the Al Agsa Mosque in Jerusalem and win the release of Palestinian security prisoners. Only 10% say they believed Hamas has committed war crimes, with a large majority saying they did not see videos showing the terrorists committing atrocities.

Why is Israel Stuck?

The depraved barbarity of 7 OCT 23 revealed a level of hatred of Israel and commitment to its destruction not previously considered.

The barbarity is two-fold: the conduct on 7 OCT 23, and the destruction its perpetrators knew, and accepted, would follow.

- a. The motives are, like ISIS, defined/motivated by Holy War
- b. HAMAS sees itself as a vanguard movement; the people of Gaza are expendable

• Israel: Defeat Hamas in Gaza...Maximize Security in Territories...Hostages' Return.


• U.S. Avoiding theater-wide war where we're dragged in...Stability...Two-State solution.

There is no visible off-ramp right now. Israel plans to fight the war to its destination—annihilation of HAMAS in Gaza.




HAMAS' ideology will be picked-up by someone else, likely just as committed to Israel's destruction.
